About the US Government's health IT stimulus:

The US Government's American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) economic stimulus package passed into Law in 2009 and is separate from the healthcare reform bill currently being debated in the US. The ARRA stimulus includes billions of dollars in incentive payments to healthcare providers for the "Meaningful Use" of certified health IT products. The incentive programme has start dates of October 2010 for hospitals and January 2011 for eligible healthcare providers.
